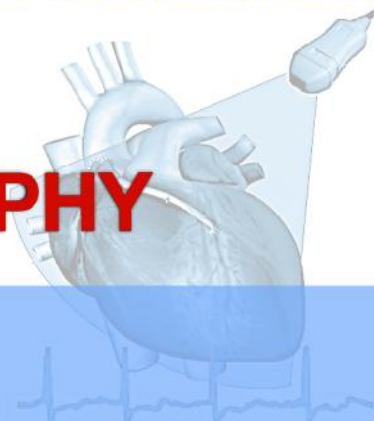

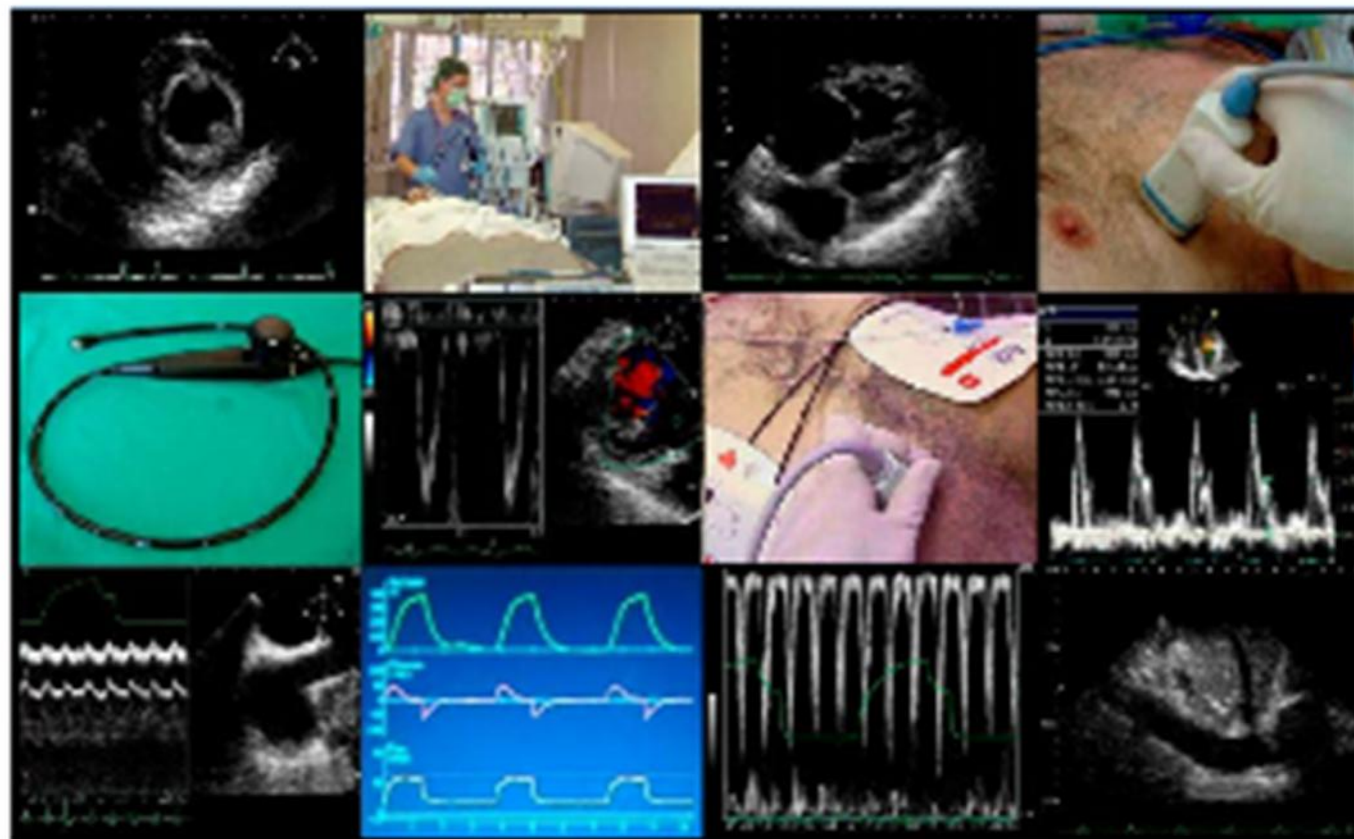

BASIC ECHO - Focused Echocardiography

A course on Echocardiography specifically designed for Intensive, Critical Care and Emergency Physicians. The course is targeted at physicians who are new to Echocardiography, and covers the use of Transthoracic Echocardiography (TTE) in the setting of cardiac arrest/periresuscitation, and as a screening tool for the unstable patient in the ICU. This module on basic Echo will include the internationally well-known formats of FEEL (Focused Echocardiography Evaluation in Life support) and FATE (Focused Assessment with Transthoracic Echocardiography), and might also be of interest to more Echo-experienced intensivists or cardiologists wishing to make their focused Echo assessment of the critical patient more effective.

This course represents the second part of an Echo training programme which follows a dedicated **E-learning course**: participants will have free access to a web-based modular training format in the months preceding the course, so as to maximize their learning and minimise time spent in **formal lectures** during the course itself. **Interactive clinical scenarios**, the **EmEchoSimTest**, and **HOT Sessions**, (Hands On Training), therefore represent the core of this course.
